Application for Disclosure- LMCS Limited (“LMCS”)

UPON READING the application made by LMCS dated 23rd September 2022;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commission, that:

1. LMCS’ application for disclosure of relevant documents between Paria Fuel Trading Company Ltd (“Paria”) and LMCS is granted.
2. Having regard to the fact that LMCS and Paria Fuel Trading Co. Ltd (“Paria”) have a direct and significant role in the matter to which this Commission of Enquiry relates and in the interests of fairness and ensuring that both LMCS and Paria are on equal footing, it is prudent that there be early and mutual discovery so that:-
 - (a) Paria shall be provided with all the documents disclosed (as at the date of this Order) by LMCS.
3. Mutual discovery shall be electronically effected by the Secretary as soon as is practicable.
4. LMCS and Paria shall use the documents received from the Secretary solely for the purpose of the Commission of Enquiry and shall not disclose the documents or their contents to any third party (save for their legal advisors, any proposed expert or
